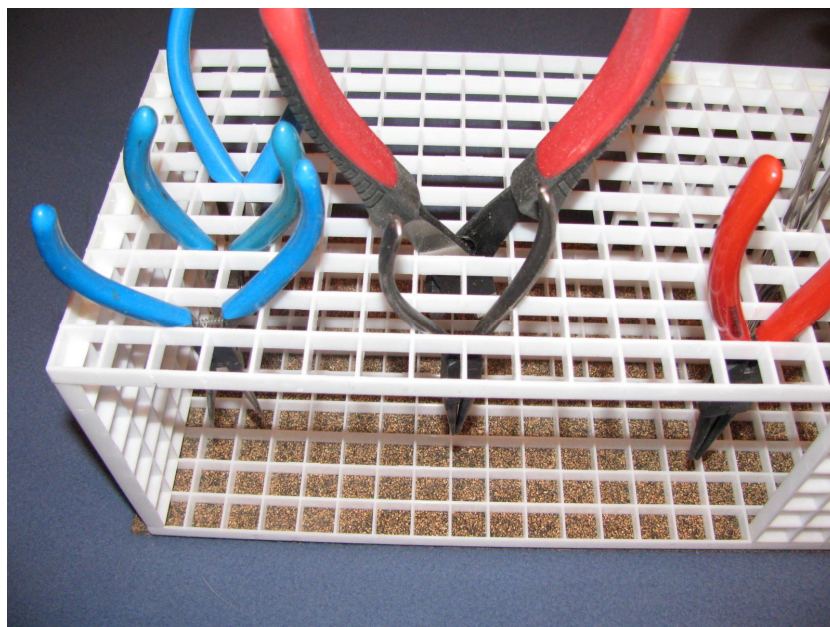
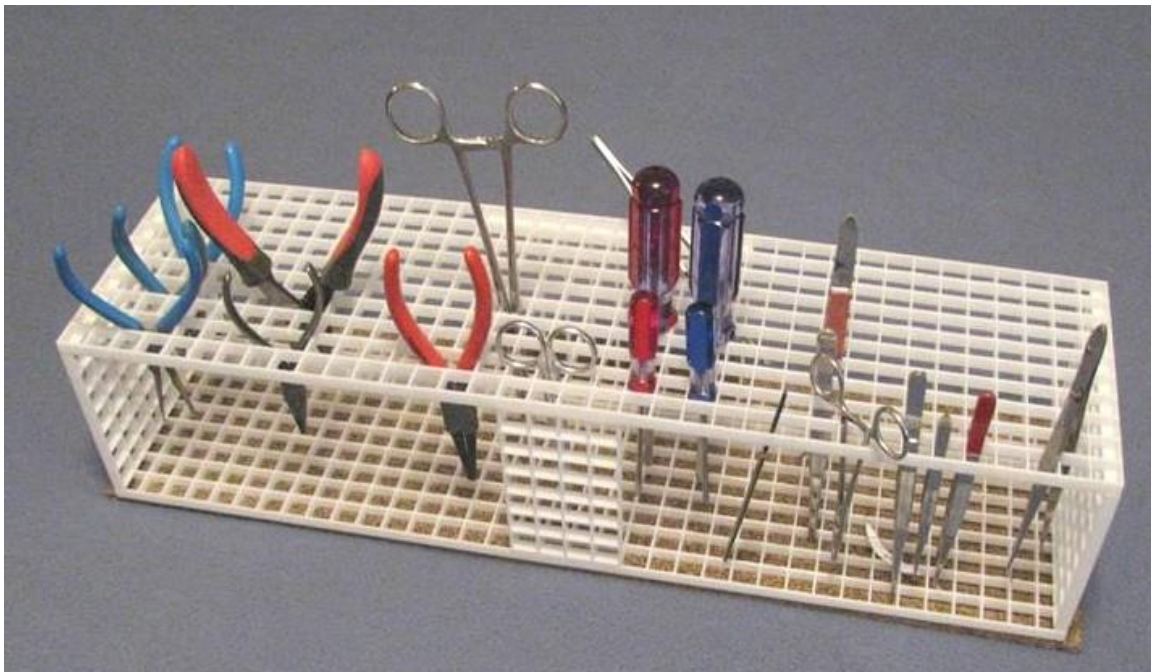
SOLUTIONS

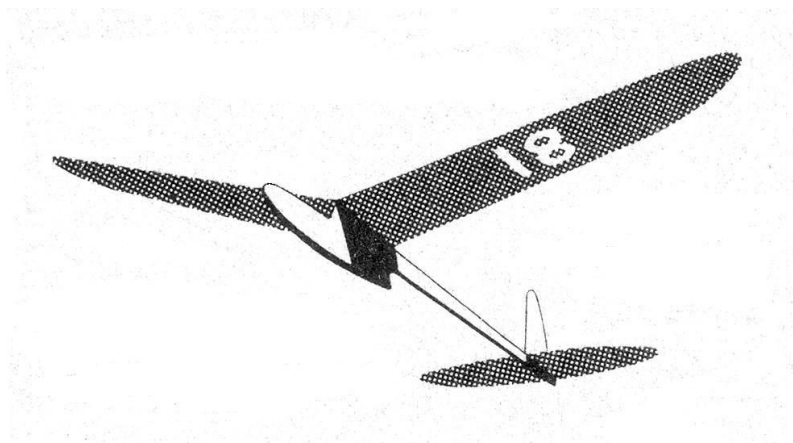
An easy workbench organizer. A couple of years ago on a model railroad layout tour in Santa Fe, I discovered one like this in Bob Hayden's shop.

It's made from a diffuser for florescent light fixtures which can be found at home centers. It's a plastic that cuts easily and can be glued together with MEK, which is in the paint section of the home center. For some of the pliers I cut out some of the partitions to fit the pliers. There is a sheet of cork under it to protect the points on some tools.

The piece in the center of the front is to provide stability and has a matching piece in the back.
